Crime Type	Sub Category	Definition
Murder		
<i>The killing of one human being by another.</i>		
Non Negligent Manslaughter		The willful killing of one human being by another.
Manslaughter By Negligence		The killing of another person through gross negligence.

Rape		
<i>The carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will.</i>		
By Force		The carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will.
Attempt		The attempted carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will.

Robbery		
<i>The taking or attempting to take anything of value from the control of a person by force or threat of force.</i>		
Highway		From a person on the street or sidewalk.
Commercial House		From a person while in a building of commerce, such as a liquor store or restaurant.
Service Station		From a person while in a gas station.
Convenience Store		From a person while in a store that sells simple items, such as snacks and groceries.
Residence		From a person while in a dwelling.
Bank		From a person while in a bank.
Miscellaneous		From a person in a setting that does not fit any above category.
	Firearm	Any firearm is used as a weapon or employed as a means of force.
	Knife or Cutting Instrument	A knife or other cutting or stabbing instrument is employed or threatened.
	Other Dangerous Weapons	Some other dangerous weapon is employed or threatened.
	Strong Arm	No weapon is used, but strong-arm tactics are employed or threatened.

Aggravated Assault		
<i>An unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury.</i>		
Domestic		Any severe domestic assault.
Firearm		A firearm is used as a weapon or employed as a means of force.
Knife or Cutting Instrument		A knife or other cutting or stabbing instrument is employed or threatened.
Other Dangerous Weapons		Some other dangerous weapon is employed or threatened.
Strong Arm		No weapon is used, but strong-arm tactics are employed or threatened.

Burglary		
<i>The unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or a theft.</i>		
Attempted Burglary		The attempted unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or a theft.
Forced Entry		The entering of a structure through use of force.
No Forced Entry		The entering of an open or unlocked structure.
	Residence	Any type of dwelling.
	Garage	Any type of garage or automobile storage area.

	Commercial	Any type of commercial house.
	Occupied	The structure is occupied at the time of the event.

Theft		
<i>The unlawful taking, carrying, leading, or riding away of property from the possession or constructive possession of another.</i>		
Except Auto Theft		A general, uncategorized theft.
Pocket Picking		The theft from a person by stealth from a victim.
Purse Snatching		The grabbing or snatching of a purse, handbag, etc., from the custody of an individual.
Shoplifting		The theft by a person (other than an employee) of goods or merchandise exposed for sale.
From Auto		The theft or articles from a motor vehicle, whether locked or unlocked.
Auto Accessories		The theft of any part or accessory attached to the interior or exterior of a motor vehicle.
Bicycle Theft		The unlawful taking of any bicycle, tandem bicycle, unicycle, etc.
From Building		A theft from within a building in which the offender has legal access.
From Coin Operated Device		A theft from a device or machine which is operated or activated by the use of a coin.
All Other		All thefts which do not fit the definition of the specific categories of larceny.
	Under \$500	A misdemeanor level theft offense.
	\$501 to \$1000	A gross misdemeanor level theft offense.
	Over \$1000	A felony level theft offense.

Motor Vehicle Theft		
<i>The theft or attempted theft of a motor vehicle.</i>		
Attempted Motor Vehicle Theft		The attempted theft of a motor vehicle.
Automobiles		The theft of a small vehicle that runs on land surface
Trucks and Buses		The theft of a large vehicle that runs on land surface
All Other Vehicles		Theft of vehicles that are not automobiles, such as motorcycles, scooters, etc.

Assault		
<i>All assaults which do not involve the use of a firearm, knife, cutting instrument, or other dangerous weapon and in which there were no serious or aggravated injuries to the victims.</i>		
Domestic		Any non-severe domestic assault.
Opposite Sex		Any non-severe domestic assault against a person of the opposite sex.
Family/Child		Any non-severe domestic assault between an adult and a child.
Gross Misdemeanor		A domestic assault that is a gross-misdemeanor.

Arson		
<i>Any willful or malicious burning or attempt to burn, with or without intent to defraud, a dwelling house, public building, motor vehicle or aircraft, personal property of another, etc.</i>		
Endangering Life		The structure is occupied at the time of the event.
Defraud Insurer		The arson was conducted to collect insurance.
Other		The event does not fit any category.
Abandoned		A property with no or an unknown owner in which nobody is present.
Residential		A private dwelling, duplex, townhouse, etc
	Single Occupancy	A single-family dwelling.

	Multiple Occupancy	A multiple-family dwelling.
Commercial, Industrial/Manufacturing		A building designated for industrial or manufacturing use.
Other Commercial		A building designated for commercial use.
Community Building		A building owned by the community, public, or government.
Storage Building		A building designated for storage.
All Other Structures		A structure that does not fit into any category.
Motor Vehicle		Any self-propelled vehicle.
Other Mobile Property		Items that do not fall into the "Motor Vehicle" definition, ex: boats, trailer.
Not Structure		Arsons of property not classified as structural or mobile.

Criminal Damage to Property

The willful destruction of another's property.

Misdemeanor		A misdemeanor level criminal damage offense.
Gross Misdemeanor		A gross misdemeanor level criminal damage offense.
Felony		A felony level criminal damage offense.

Graffiti

The use of graffiti without permission on another's property.

Misdemeanor		A misdemeanor level graffiti offense.
Gross Misdemeanor		A gross misdemeanor level graffiti offense.
Felony		A felony level graffiti offense.

Narcotics

The violation of laws that pertain to controlled substances.

Possession		The possession of illegal controlled substances.
Selling		The selling of illegal controlled substances.
Possession With Intent to Sell		The possession with intent to sell illegal controlled substances.
Loitering With Intent to Sell		Loitering with intent to sell illegal controlled substances.
	Opium or Cocaine	A narcotic offense related to Opium or Cocaine.
	Cocaine	A narcotic offense related to Cocaine.
	Heroin	A narcotic offense related to Heroin.
	Methamphetamine	A narcotic offense related to Methamphetamine.
	MDMA (Ecstasy)	A narcotic offense related to MDMA (Ecstasy).
	Synthetic Narcotic, Demerol, Etc.	A narcotic offense related to Synthetic Narcotic, Demerol, Etc.
	Dangerous Non-Narcotic Drugs	A narcotic offense related to Dangerous Non-Narcotic Drugs.
