## **Narrative:**

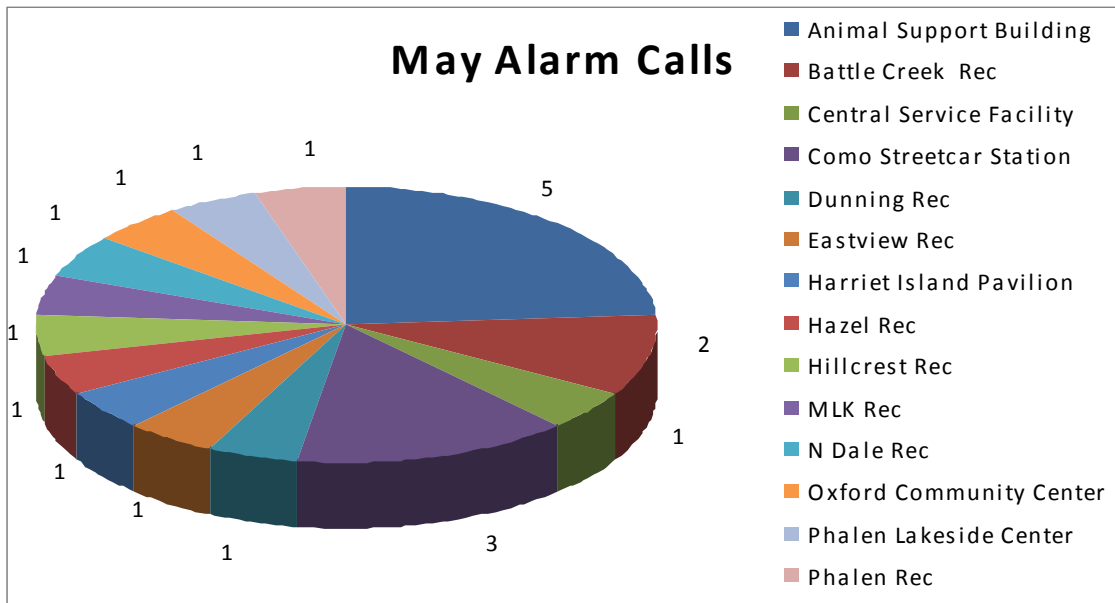
