Pedicab License

Overview

Pedicab: a nonmotorized three-wheel bicycle used to carry passengers for hire; license required.

Pedicab Business: the business of operating a pedicab for hire for the recreational or physical transportation of the general public.

Pedicab Driver: any person who operates, drives, or propels a pedicab; license required.

Code Requirements

See Chapter 375 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

Application Requirements

You must submit the following:

- Class R License Application;
- Pedicab Inspection Report (request Licensing at 651-266-8989 to arrange);
- Certificate of Insurance proof with the limits of not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for injury or death to one (1) person, three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for each occurrence, and one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) for property damage; proof of insurance shall comply with Sec. 310.07(b) of the Legislative Code; the City of Saint Paul does not need to be named as an additional insured, but must be a certificate holder and receive the maximum advance notice of cancellation;
- Required fee.

Expiration & Renewal

A Pedicab License will expire one year from date of issuance and may be renewed annually.
