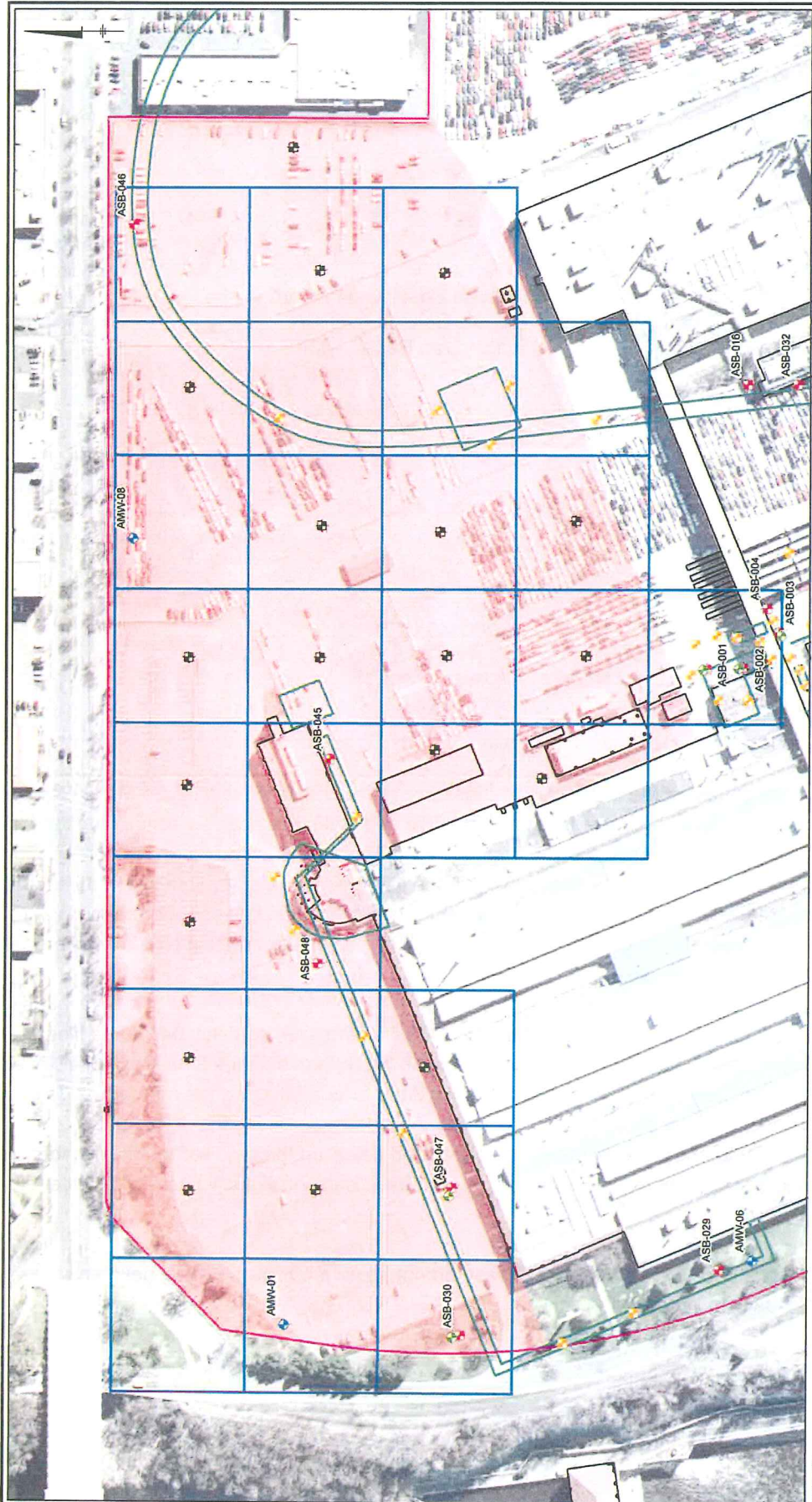

Subject: Statistical Analysis Request for North
Parking Area

As discussed during the course of the June 20, 2012 meeting at your office location, Ford Motor Company (Ford) wishes to submit this formal request for the completion of a statistical analysis concerning the North Parking Area (NPA) of the Twin Cities Assembly Plant (TCAP). This analysis would provide Ford with an understanding of the number of borings necessary within the NPA to meet the required spatial distribution for consideration of No Further Action (NFA) for the current property use designation. Furthermore, for future consideration, an understanding of the required spatial distribution for meeting NFA for the property to meet residential use is also requested.


Please find attached a figure depicting the extent of the North Parking Area as described in the North Parking Area – Supplemental Phase II – Exterior Investigation Work Plan submitted on May 19, 2008 and approved by the MPCA on July 8, 2009. The North Parking Area is located along the northern edge of the TCAP property and encompasses approximately 29 acres. As discussed during the June 20, 2012 meeting, it is understood that the result of this request is based solely on the required spatial distribution, and does not take into consideration necessary delineation based on acquired soil and groundwater analytical data.

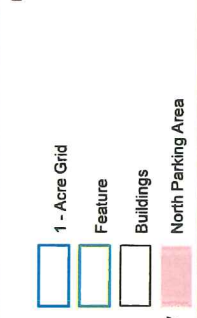
