NOTES:

- Grades 1-3 from Capitol Hill use playground and open space extensively during lunch
- Which user group (Capitol Hill, Public, MLK/HQB), if any, has priority to use space?
- Daycare providers walk to park with children daily
- Incorporate a water feature into the design (splash pad, sand/water play)
 - o Children are attracted to water features
 - Issues with sanitation and regulations
 - Increased maintenance
 - Small budget
 - o Large infrastructure (pumps, cisterns) for relatively small feature
- More swings are needed
- Climbing structures are recommended. Students climb everything from trees to buildings
- A meeting participant recommended modern/climbing system
- Incorporate springing equipment
- Synthetic rock climbing structures seem dangerous
- Opportunity to join with MN Vikings to build support and raise funds
- Opportunity to construct play area through volunteer effort similar to Rondo Education Center
