Dear Saint Paul Resident / Property Owner:

On August 5, 2015 the Saint Paul City Council directed Saint Paul Public Works to form a Community Working Group to develop a neighborhood-supported north-south bicycle route that runs from Randolph Avenue to University Avenue between Fairview Avenue and Mississippi River Boulevard. The Community Working Group is comprised of representatives from local District Councils, businesses, bicycle advocacy groups, and nearby colleges. **The Community Working Group is considering a bike route on either Cleveland Avenue or Prior Avenue.**

Wednesday, October 28th the Community Working Group is hosting a public Open House to present findings and potential recommendations to the community.

Project Details:

The Saint Paul Bike Plan, adopted in March of 2015, identifies Cleveland Avenue from Ford Parkway to University as a future bike route. Ramsey County completed a mill and overlay of Cleveland between Randolph and Summit in the fall of 2015. During the mill and overlay planning the City considered implementing bike facilities along that portion of Cleveland. In June of 2015 the Saint Paul City Council voted to delay implementation until a more robust community process could take place. With the northern half of Cleveland slated for a mill and overlay in 2016 the project area was expanded north to University Avenue and a Community Working Group was formed.
