2009 PICNIC RESERVATION RATES AND INFORMATION (FOR GROUPS UP TO 999 PEOPLE)

(For groups of 1000 or more, please see Large Event and Community Festival Reservations)

THE PICNIC SEASON RUNS FROM MAY 2, 2009 THROUGH OCTOBER 4, 2009
(Some facilities close earlier in October)

Residents and businesses of the City of Saint Paul proper may apply for permits beginning Friday, January 2, 2009. Non residents/businesses may apply beginning Monday, February 2, 2009. Only one permit application will be accepted per day from any group, individual, or organization.

Reservations for the Newell Building and the Como Streetcar Station ONLY: City of Saint Paul residents and businesses may apply for a permit the first business day of the month, 13 months in advance of their desired event date. Nonresidents and businesses may apply beginning the first business day of the month, 12 months in advance of their desired event date.

All applications must be made at least seven days prior to the event.

PERMIT SESSIONS: The day is divided into two sessions. If you would like to reserve the entire day, you are required to pay for two sessions. **TIME SESSIONS AVAILABLE:**

ONE SESSION: 7:30 A.M. until 2:30 P.M. OR 4:00 P.M. until 10:00 P.M.

TWO SESSIONS (ALL DAY): 7:30 A.M. until 10:00 P.M.

Please Note: Setup and Cleanup times need to be included in your rental time.

CHANGES TO PERMITS: Changes to date or location of an event will be accepted up to 7 days prior to the scheduled date of the event. There will be a \$10.00 charge each time you alter your picnic permit (time session change, date change, location change).

CANCELLATIONS: Refunds for cancellations requested at least **14 calendar days** in advance of an event will be issued as follows:

No refunds are given due to weather conditions. If a permit is issued within 14 days of an event, and the event is canceled, the permit fee is not refundable.

DUNK TANKS, LARGE GAMES AND TENTS

Fee for Dunk Tank Water Usage: \$55.00, Non-Profit/Tax Exempt Rate: \$51.15

- Liability insurance is required.
- The Permit Office must be notified at least 7 days prior to event. Parks staff will determine the location for the dunk tank.
- Parks does NOT supply hose for connection from dunk tank to water source.

Site Fees for rides, large games, pony rides and petting zoo areas for one area: \$55.00,

Tax Exempt Rate: \$51.15 **Each additional ride, large game, pony ride and petting zoo area: \$30.00, Tax Exempt Rate: \$27.90**

- The Park Permit Office must be notified of and give approval for all rides, large games, pony rides and petting zoo areas.
- If any rides or large games require staking, the Permit Office must be notified at least 7 days prior to an event.
- Liability insurance is required.
- Please Note: Some rides, large games, and petting zoos are not allowed in Como Park. Contact the Permit Office for additional information.

Fee for Tent Area - one site: \$55.00, Tax Exempt Rate: \$51.15. Each additional tent: \$30.00. Tax Exempt Rate: \$27.90

- The Permit Office will determine location.
- **If the tent requires staking, the Permit Office must be notified at least seven (7) days prior to an event by calling 651-632-5111.**

Tent locations MUST be located for underground utilities before installation.

RENTAL AND RATE INFORMATION:

- No reservations are taken for any national holidays, or the day immediately preceding or following a holiday.
- Prices include Minnesota sales tax.
- Non-Profit /Tax Exempt discount rates are available on facility rental fees as listed below to groups who provide proper documentation of such status at the time of application. The large group, tent, large game, inflatable and dunk tank fee prices are not discounted except for the reduction of fees due to tax exempt status.
- For groups that are non-profit but not tax exempt, 7% will be added back into non-profit/tax exempt fees listed.
- The rates listed below are for groups of 99 or less. If the rental is for a group of 100 or more, there

are additional fees (refer to the large group fees).

CHEROKEE PARK - Cherokee Boulevard between Annapolis and Baker Streets, 55107. Available: 2 picnic shelters, restroom building, tot lot, 1 backstop on Annapolis and Chippewa, 1 basketball court, 2 tennis courts on Baker and Cherokee, barbecue grills, and 2 scenic overlooks.

Alcohol - The possession and consumption of non-intoxicating malt liquor (containing not more than 3.2% alcohol by weight) is permitted from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. within the designated picnic areas. Glass beverage containers are not allowed.

Large Shelter - Seats approximately 100 people. Electricity is available.

COMO PARK - Hamline Avenue and Midway Parkway, 55108. Available: 1 picnic shelter, 1 picnic pavilion, 2 restroom buildings, tot lot, 4 tennis courts, 4 ball fields, barbecue grills, 3 fire rings, main and wading pools, golf course, Como Zoo (Lancer Catering operates a picnic pavilion within the zoo grounds, call 651-290-9864 for more information), Conservatory, Cafejian's Carousel, amusement rides (please note: the ride area is open spring and summer through Labor Day), miniature golf, fishing pier, paddleboat rental and paved trails.

Alcohol - The possession and consumption of non-intoxicating malt liquor (containing not more than 3.2% alcohol by weight) is permitted from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. within the designated picnic areas. Glass beverage containers are not allowed.

Como Park Midway Picnic Pavilion - 1199 Midway Parkway, 55108 (Horton and Midway Parkway) (East Picnic Grounds) - open sided with wrought iron fencing, adjoining picnic pavilions that can be rented separately or as one. Each side seats approximately 125 people. Both sides have a kitchen with a gas stove (no oven), sinks, electricity and a serving counter. The south side has a walk-in cooler (no freezer) and the north side has a commercial size refrigerator with a freezer. Each side has a large barbecue grill located behind the kitchen area. There is also a separate restroom building at the site. *Please Note: Groups with an estimated attendance of more than 150 people will be required to reserve the entire pavilion.*

Como Park Picnic Shelter - Midway Parkway near Hamline Avenue, 55108 (West Picnic Grounds) - seats approximately 50 people. The shelter has electricity and a large double grill. A restroom, play area and drinking fountain are nearby. *Note: The maximum size group that picnic permits will be issued to for this shelter is 99 people. No tents are allowed in the West Picnic Grounds.*

Como Streetcar Station - 1224 No. Lexington Parkway, 55103. The Streetcar Station is a heated and air-conditioned facility available for year-round rental. *The building is not available for rentals on Sundays from 10:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. as it is open to the public every Sunday as a Streetcar Museum from 12:00 p.m. (noon) to 4:00 p.m.*

Reservations for the Newell Building and the Como Streetcar Station ONLY: City of Saint Paul residents and businesses may apply for a permit the first business day of the month, 13 months in advance of their desired event date. Nonresidents and businesses may apply beginning the first business day of the month, 12 months in advance of their desired event date.

Building capacity is a maximum of 75 people. Please take note of the following:

- The space has a maximum setup capacity for 50 people using tables and chairs. This does not include space for display/serving tables.
- Auditorium style-seated events (with chairs only) have a maximum setup capacity of 75 people. This does not include space for display/serving tables.

CROSBY PARK - 2560 Crosby Farm Road, 55116. Available: 1 picnic shelter with fire pit and 1 barbeque grill, restroom building, drinking fountain, Watergate Marina, fishing in Upper Lake, Crosby Lake and the Mississippi River. **Alcohol** - The possession or consumption of alcohol is prohibited in this park.

Shelter with a fireplace - Seats approximately 50 people. Electricity is available.

HIGHLAND PARK - Montreal between Edgcombe Road and Lexington Parkway, 55116.

Available: 1 picnic pavilion, 1 picnic shelter, booya shed, barbecue grills, 1 fire ring, 9 hole disc golf, 4 tennis courts, main and wading pools, 9 hole and 18 hole golf courses, and horseshoe pit.

Alcohol - The possession and consumption of non-intoxicating malt liquor (containing not more than 3.2% alcohol by weight) is permitted from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. within the designated picnic areas. Glass beverage containers are not allowed.

Highland Picnic Pavilion - 1200 Montreal Avenue, 55116 - Seats approximately 200 people, fireplace, kitchen facilities including sinks, stoves, walk-in cooler and hot plates. *Please Note: Groups with an estimated attendance of more than 100 people will be required to reserve the entire pavilion.*

Newell Building - 900 N. Fairview, 55102. Accommodates a maximum of 100 people, has a kitchen area with a stove, refrigerator, sink, serving window, tables, and chairs. The setup of tables and chairs is the responsibility of the permit holder. *The building is heated and is available for rental year-round. Please contact the Park Permit Office at 651-632-5111 for information on how to reserve the building outside of the picnic season.*

Nonresidents and businesses may apply beginning the first business day of the month, 12 months in advance of their desired event date.

Glass beverage containers are not allowed.

Phalen Picnic Pavilion - 1600 Phalen Drive, 55106 - Seats approximately 300 people, 2 kitchens with water, stove tops, coolers, electricity, serving counters, and fireplace. Each side has a large barbeque grill on the patio area facing the lake. *Please Note: Groups with an estimated attendance of more than 175 people will be required to reserve the entire pavilion.*
