In addition to getting your EMT certification, it boils down to your willingness to serve because this career can be very demanding. You can be in various environments, it could be during the middle of the night and outside could be hot or cold. You don't know what the situation is going to call for and what's going to be asked of you. You have to be willing and have the right attitude to do what it takes to best serve the community.

Hiring Process

We will begin accepting applications **April 2, 2018**. Firefight/EMT Written Test is scheduled for **June 1, 2018**. Mark the dates on your calendar!

Candidates must submit a job application and an application fee of \$50. Financial hardship waivers will be available for those who qualify. The application fee does not apply to City of Saint Paul residents. Applicants must live in the City limits and submit proof of residency in order to have the fee waived.

Payments can be made online or by cash in person after you've applied at the Office of Human Resources at 200 City Hall Annex, 25 W. 4th Street, Saint Paul, MN 55102.

Firefighter Trainee

Salary: \$20.45 hourly

Performs trainee duties as a student in the Saint Paul Fire Academy, working a forty-hour (40) work week for 16 weeks. Recruits attend classes to learn fire procedures and other fire-related subject matter.
