Hiring Process

Now accepting applications online for Firefighter/EMT through Monday, **April 30**, **2018**, **4:30** p.m.

Firefight/EMT Written Exam is scheduled for **June 1, 2018**. See more information below.

Candidates must submit an online job application and an application fee of \$50. Economic hardship waivers will be available for those who qualify. The application fee does not apply to City of Saint Paul residents. Applicants must live in the City limits and submit proof of residency in order to have the fee waived.

Payments can be made online or by cash in person at the Office of Human Resources at 200 City Hall Annex, 25 W. 4th Street, Saint Paul, MN 55102.

we encounter isn't something taken lightly. I feel like I have too many brothers and sisters to count!

What did you do to prepare for the testing process when you applied?

When I prepared to take the test I found a civil service test prep book to help with the written test. As far as the physical test prep I bought a weight vest to wear around, ran stairs with a sandbag, and built a keiser sled replica with a log of wood and sledge hammer to simulate that movement. During my exercises I pushed myself to a point I had never felt during regular workouts. Now they have more physical prep sessions and opportunities to practice with the actual equipment from the test and a workout training manual on the city website. My advice is to utilize that to maximize your success.

How does an EMT differ from a Paramedic?

On this job we do a lot of medical 911 calls so we need to have either an EMT certification or a Paramedic certification. While someone doesn't need to be an EMT to apply they must have the EMT certification to get an interview. An EMT and Paramedic work together side by side every day on the ambulance. The EMT is an entry level certification and a Paramedic is a more advanced level of prehospital care. It generally takes less than 6 months to become an EMT and one to two years to become a Paramedic. Paramedics will do all the skills that an EMT will do, plus a Paramedic will perform advanced lifesaving skills such as intubations, IV's, and drug administration.
