Firefight/EMT Written Exam is scheduled for **June 1**, **2018**. See more information below.

Candidates must submit an online job application **and** an application fee of \$50. Economic hardship waivers will be available for those who qualify. The application fee does not apply to City of Saint Paul residents. Applicants must live in the City limits and submit proof of residency in order to have the fee waived.

Payments can be made online or by cash in person at the Office of Human Resources at 200 City Hall Annex, 25 W. 4th Street, Saint Paul, MN 55102.

How do you support the mission of the City of Saint Paul and the Fire Department?

I currently serve as the Chief of Community Relations, so I do most things that aren't operations related. I do recruiting, I work with the EMS academy, public relations, public education, and community events. My job is about improving racial equity and making the Fire department a positive part of the community. These are just a few ways that I support the Fire and City missions.

What knowledge and skills do you need to be successful as a Firefighter?

Being a good team player will make you a very successful Firefighter/EMT. No one knows everything. There are days where you're working the streets and you're in a situation that you have no knowledge of. Being able to work as a team and relying on one another is a great strength.

I would say you also need to be a problem solver, creative, dedicated to the mission, and want to serve. These are the big things that make you a success Firefighter/EMT. Your commitment to service and wanting to give back to the community will help drive your career.

What did you do to prepare for the testing process when you applied?

To prepare for the Physical Performance Test, I bought a back pack and put sand in it. I started with 40 pounds, eventually working my way up to 70 pounds of sand. There used to be a long stair way on the west side and I would just climb stairs until I was tired.

As I progressed I went to a surplus store and bought a fire hose. So it was a bundle that weighed around 75 pounds. I would do stairs with the weighted back pack and hose bundle.
