1. Do you have a modified AAP?

- a. The city provided AAP Registration is the modified and simplest version of a full AAP available.
- 2. I am not a contractor.
 - a. For the purpose of AA/EEO compliance monitoring everyone is a "contractor." Please see the definition of terms.
- 3. The AA/EEO document is written for construction projects, and we are not a construction vendor. I don't think the city's AA/EEO applies to my company.
 - a. The city's AA/EEO document is a blanket document that covers all types of companies and contracts with the City of Saint Paul.
- 4. Can we submit our Affirmative Action Policy Statement in lieu of the AAP? a. No.
- 5. Who do I make the check out to?
 - a. Make the check payable to the "City of St Paul."
- 6. Who and where do I send the check to?

- 7. Reciprocity. My company is compliant and we have a certificate of compliance from the State of MN. I don't have to do anything for the city?
 - a. Not true, you must register your AAP plan with the city.
- 8. When should I renew my AAP?
 - a. Your new AAP and fee must be received by HREEO before it expires.

9. My AAP expired, what do you need from me to renew?

a. Expired AAP certificate of compliance are not renewed until you submit the new AAP registration document with the required fee.

10. My company is:

- a. Small and minority owned. I am exempt from AA/EEO requirement.
 - i. No, you are not exempt from practicing equal and fair employment rules and regulations.
- b. My company has less than 40 employees. I am exempt from AA/EEO requirement.
 - i. No, you are not exempt from practicing equal and fair employment rules and regulations.

11. Who is exempt from filing an Affirmative Action Program with the City of St Paul?

- a. If your one-time contract is under \$50,000.00, and/or
- b. If within the last 12 months, you have received less than \$50,000.00 of any type of City funds.

12. My AAP certificate has expired or is expiring, what do you need from me to renew?

- a. Complete the city-provided AAP Registration document or submit your own current AAP:
 - i. Scan and email a copy of the AAP to affirmativeaction@ci.stpaul.mn.us
 - ii. Mail the \$75 check as stated in #5 and #6 above.
