OPEN BURNING REQUIRMENTS

Revised 4/2020

Open burning is permitted under the following conditions:

- 1. Open Burning requires a fire permit from the Saint Paul DSI Fire Safety Inspection Division.
- 2. Open Burning can be used for disposal, except that paper products and materials that may produce obnoxious smoke and odors cannot be burned.
- 3. Prior to ignition, the Fire Department must be notified at 651-266-7702.
- 4. Open burning shall not be conducted within 50 feet of a building or other combustible material.
- 5. Open Burning may be conducted within 25 feet of a building or other combustible material if the pile size is no more than 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet high.
- 6. Open Burning may be conducted within 15 feet of a building or other combustible material if the burning takes place solely within an approved burning appliance.
- 7. Any conditions which could cause a fire to spread to within 50 feet of a building shall be eliminated prior to ignition.
- 8. The means shall be provided to extinguish the fire. This includes buckets, shovels, garden hoses, or a minimum 4A fire extinguisher.
- 9. Fires shall be constantly attended by a person knowledgeable in the use of the fire extinguishing equipment provided.
- 10. Fires shall not be ignited if the wind speed is 10 mph or more.
- 11. The fire department may order the fire to be discontinued if, in their opinion, the fire constitutes a hazardous condition or produces obnoxious smoke or odors that may cause a public nuisance.
