How to Get Rid of Unwanted Items

The City of Saint Paul has several programs, resources, and partner organizations to help residents Recycle Smart by properly disposing of unwanted items. This guide provides information on how to reuse and recycle; get rid of large, bulky items; and safely dispose of hazardous waste.

Choose to Reuse or Donate

If your unwanted items are in good condition, explore options to donate or reuse before throwing them away.



Tips for Donating

- Call ahead for hours, fees, location, and any special COVID-19 requirements.
- Pre-sort your donations (clothing, kitchenware, decor, etc.).
- Only donate things in good condition. Donation centers and thrift stores must pay to dispose of stuff they cannot sell.

Bulky Item Disposal Options

Households with Citywide Garbage Service

Bulky items include materials that are too large or are prohibited by law to put inside your garbage and recycling carts, such as mattresses, furniture, appliances, and electronics.

Saint Paul's Citywide Garbage Collection Program (for residential 1-4 unit properties) includes a number of FREE bulky item pick-ups each calendar year.

- › Small Cart = 2 Bulky Items
- › Medium or Large Cart = 3 Bulky Items

Additional bulky items can be collected for a fee, ranging from \$10 - \$55 per item, plus tax.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

If a container has the words "Caution," "Warning," "Danger," or "Poison" on the label and still has product inside, it cannot be disposed of in the garbage or recycling. Use the FREE Ramsey County HHW Collection Site for safe and proper disposal.
