- One hauler services each block.

Trash service provided by all current haulers, including small and local companies.

Four levels of service, including every other week collection.



High-quality customer service with direct connection to your hauler.



Three bulky items included in base service.



Easy and consistent billing process.



Walk-up service for the elderly and people with disabilities.



Average estimated annual savings:
