## GOOD HOUSEKEEPING RULES

- ➤ Keep work areas clean including rest rooms and break areas.
- ➤ Do not store any materials near doors, stairways, and walkways even temporarily.
- ➤ Clean up scrap lumber and debris around machinery.
- > Do not stack items so that they are hanging over the edge of shelves.
- ➤ Place signage in any areas where there is a wet or slippery floor.
- ➤ Keep commonly used items in areas where they are easily accessible.
- > Clean up all spills immediately using the proper method of cleaning.
- ➤ Pick up debris even if you did not leave it.
- > Close the drawers on all file cabinets.
- ➤ Do not allow wires to hang where someone could hit them or laying on the floor where someone could trip on them.
- Ensure stair railings are properly fastened and at the right height.
- ➤ Make sure entrances and exits are properly lit especially at night.
- ➤ Report any broken or defective items to a supervisor or manager immediately.
