## American Indian Economic Base, Saint Paul- 2007

- 130 million dollars in buying power \*
  - 120 firms with 11 million dollars in sales. \*\*
  - In the Twin Cities MSA: \*\*
    - 1305 firms with \$135 million in sales.
    - 247 of these had paid employees
  - Major sectors for American Indian firms in Minnesota: Construction, Administration, Arts and Entertainment and Manufacturing.
  - Per capita income of \$ 27, 142 – highest of all minority groups.^
  - 40 percent of households own their homes.^
  - 307 thousand dollars in rent #
  - 272 thousand dollars in real estate taxes#
  - 13 million dollars in state and local taxes\*
  - 70 percent have high school education or greater. 14 percent have a bachelor's degree or higher.\*
  - 4817 people or 2 percent of the population of Saint Paul
