BENEFITS

Carpenters do not receive City benefits. Employer contributions are made on behalf of employees for union-provided fringe benefits. Rates in all grades except 004 include a taxable vacation contribution of \$1.20 per hour plus:

- \$1.41 per hour for all employees holding the classification of Carpenter (Grade 001)
- \$1.49 per hour for all employees holding the classification of Carpenter (Grade 002)
- \$1.56 per hour for all employees holding the classification of Building Inspector (Grade 006) and Senior Building Inspector (Grade 003)

OVERTIME

Overtime rate of one and one-half (1.5) the basic hourly rate shall be paid for work performed under the following circumstances:

- Time worked in excess of eight (8) hours in a normal work day; and
- Time worked in excess of forty (40) hours in any seven (7) day period

Paid in time and one-half in compensatory time or money determined solely by the Employer.

CALL IN/CALL BACK

Employees called in or called back shall receive a minimum of four (4) hours straight time pay at the basic hourly rate or shall be compensated in accordance with Article 8 (Overtime), when applicable whichever is greater.
