

RESOLUTION #11-09
Mounds Park Master Plan

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission (“Commission”) is an appointed body established to advise the Mayor and City Council on long-range and Citywide matters related to the Department of Parks and Recreation; and

WHEREAS, Indian Mounds Park is one of Saint Paul’s first parks and was designated a major Regional Park in 1974; and

WHEREAS, a master plan for Indian Mounds Regional Park has not been completed since 1981; and

WHEREAS, this is a regional and Citywide community park which is in need of improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation organized a design task force consisting of representatives from District 4, Lower Phalen Creek, the National Park Service (NPS), Friends of Mississippi River, and Friends of Parks and Trails to develop an updated park master plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed master plan is consistent with the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Comprehensive Plan and the City of Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Systems Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission hereby endorses the amended Master Plan document for Indian Mounds Regional Park which will be submitted to the Metropolitan Council for approval.
