Hillcrest Recreation Center Name Selection

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission is an appointed body established to advise the Mayor and City Council on long-range and city-wide matters related to Parks and Recreation; and

WHEREAS, the City owns a facility located at 1978 Ford Parkway, that has housed the Hillcrest Recreation Center and Highland Park Library that have always been recognized as two separate entities, located within the one building; and

WHEREAS, the site went through a major renovation in 2014 and it is the desire of both City Departments to give the facility a unified name; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to install signage that reflects an official name for the facility and is used on City maps and location reference materials; and

WHEREAS, Saint Paul Parks and Recreation and the Saint Paul Public Library have unanimously selected the name, “Highland Park Community Center”, as the name of the newly renovated facility; and

WHEREAS, the Highland District Council also supports the name selection of “Highland Park Community Center”; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission endorses the proposal to officially name the facility, located at 1978 Ford Parkway, the “Highland Park Community Center”.
