Bike Walk Central Corridor Action Plan

The City of Saint Paul is currently preparing a plan to create a safe and more inviting pedestrian and bicycle environment in Saint Paul's Central Corridor. It will identify the primary network for pedestrian and bicycle movement and make recommendations for route improvements, support facilities, programs, and safety measures to encourage walking and biking to and around the future Light Rail Transit (LRT) stations and within the Central Corridor. The Plan recommendations will be designed to increase bicycling and walking and decrease reliance on the automobile. In addition, the plan will prioritize achievable projects for implementation in the near future.

Project Status

The Central Corridor Bike-Walk planning team has been out in the corridor evaluating bike-walk opportunities, identifying problem areas and talking with stakeholders groups. That research work will build on the information gathered during the LRT station area planning, neighborhood plans and your input and ideas. A draft Bike-Walk Action Plan will be prepared for public review in February, 2009 with anticipated completion of the Plan in March of 2009. Funding for the Central Corridor Bike-Walk Action Plan is provided by a grant from the Non-Motorized Transportation Pilot Program.
