

Vision of Economic Vitality




- Inspired by 8-80 Cities and Gil Penalosa

 - Retain and attract residents, businesses, employees and visitors

8-80 Vitality Investment

- City Council approved the Mayor's 8-80 Vitality Fund in October.
- \$42.5 million in projects
- Projects include:
 - Downtown Bike Loop
 - Grand Round
 - Palace Theatre
 - Dickerman Park
 - Streets & Public Spaces
- Three year timeline (through 2017)

8-80 Principles



Every city should have a law of two words:
Pedestrians First

- Walkability
- Bikeability
- Public Spaces
- Public Transportation



8-80 Vitality Fund Projects



Feature projects:

- **Palace Theatre** - \$8M
- **Downtown Bike Loop** design development and Jackson St segment construction - \$8.45M
- **Grand Round**, North Loop design development and partial construction - \$13.2M
- **Dickerman Park** - \$2M

Public Space Investments:

- **Lexington Commons** - \$1.5M
- **Central Station Plaza** - \$1M
- **Little Mekong Plaza** - \$300K
- **River Balcony** design development - \$100K

Street Investments:

- **Randolph and Lexington** Intersection Improvements - \$1.5M
- **Raymond Avenue Phase II** Reconstruction - \$1.46M
- **Payne and Bedford** Intersection Improvements - \$1M
- **N Snelling Avenue** Sidewalk and Median Improvements - \$525K
- **Bike Lane Striping** - \$400K
- **Payne and E 7th St** Intersection and **Bruce Vento Trailhead** Improvements - \$225K



Downtown Bike Loop




- Separated bike lane


