2014 NBRP INSTALLATIONS

OVERVIEW

The City of Saint Paul has made significant progress in the provision of bicycle parking in 2014. Funding received from Transit for Livable Communities was used to install 22 new bicycle racks at nine locations throughout the City as part of the Neighborhood Bike Rack Program (NBRP). Additionally, Saint Paul's first on-street bike corral was approved and permitted on a public roadway.

Outside the program, the year also saw the mapping of bike parking locations to the City's public GIS website, the accommodation and installation of customized Highland Park racks as part of the Highland Village Streetscape Program, and the installation of over 100 bike hitches in downtown.

What follows is information and photos of each installation included in the NBRP in 2014.

BANG BREWING



Location: 2320 Capp Road

Rack Styles: On-street corral

Description: Public Works green lit the first on-street bike corral in Saint Paul at Bang Brewing Company. The on-street corral is located in the parking lane, providing a high capacity bike parking solution. The City waived the permit fees for this project.

LULULEMON

Location: 870 Grand Avenue

Rack Styles: Hitch Rack (3)

Description: Three red hitch racks were installed in front of Lululemon's Grand Avenue shop, providing convenient bike parking for several businesses.



2014 NBRP INSTALLATIONS

FROGTOWN GARDENS



Location: 630 Dale Street

Rack Styles: Frogtown Racks (3)

Description: Smart Trips worked with community members through their Frogtown Neighborhoods Program to develop this special design for Frogtown. The Department of Public Works chipped in, buying three of the new racks installed at the Popup Tree Park at Dale & Lafond.

BREADSMITH

Location: 1579 Grand Avenue

Rack Styles: Hitch Rack (2)

Description: A pair of galvanized hitch racks were installed at the busy intersection of Snelling & Grand.



COMMON GOOD BOOKS



Location: 38 Snelling Avenue South

Rack Styles: Hitch Rack (2)

Description: Common Good Books requested some new racks, in addition to a few that were installed in 2009. We were able to put in two new bike hitches to provide even more parking at this location.

2014 NBRP INSTALLATIONS

PAD THAI

Location: 1679 Grand Avenue

Rack Styles: Hitch Rack (1)

Description: We added a second rack at Pad Thai on Grand, adding to the existing rack installed in 2009.



PEAPODS NATURAL TOYS

Location: 2290 Como Avenue

Rack Styles: Hitch Rack (2)

Description: A pair of hitch racks was installed on Como Avenue in front of Peapods Natural Toys. These racks provide bike parking along the existing bike lanes on Como.



SAINT PAUL YOGA & SALON ORI

Location: 1162 Selby Avenue

Rack Styles: Hitch Rack (4)

Description: In our first attempt at installing concrete to allow for an installation, we accommodated requests from two local businesses on Selby Avenue. The four racks will serve both Saint Paul Yoga and Salon Ori.



2014 NBRP INSTALLATIONS

LIVE GREEN APARTMENTS

Location: Old Kellogg Boulevard

Rack Styles: Hitch Rack (1) Bike Bike Rack (1)

Description: We worked with Live Green Apartments to add these two racks in the shadow of the Saint Paul Cathedral. Live Green contributed to the project to upgrade one of the racks to a bike style.



ACME DELI



Location: 1552 Saint Clair Avenue

Rack Styles: Hitch Rack (3)

Description: Three hitch racks were installed in front of the commercial building on the southwest corner of Saint Clair and Brimhall owned by Live Green.
