Como Regional Park Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes – February 16, 2012

Como Regional Park Signage and Wayfinding RFP review

The primary agenda item at this meeting was to review proposals from three vendors who submitted bids for the Como Regional Park Signage and Wayfinding Plan. The results of our recommendation cannot be published at this writing, as the information is confidential until a bid is awarded.

The committee was thoughtful in its review of the proposals and did forward a recommendation to the Parks Design staff and the staff from Contract & Analysis Services. The recommendation included a few questions that the committee felt were important to include in the interview, as well as the names of individual committee members who were willing to participate in the interview.

The committee requests that a vendor be in place by the next CRPAC meeting. All copies of the proposals and the written recommendations have been forwarded to the Parks Design Section, and the Contract and Analysis staff.
