Como Regional Park Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes – December 13, 2011

The Signage and Wayfinding RFP was finalized and will be submitted to Contract & Analysis Services for their review and official posting.

Initial discussion about re-purposing Como Golf Course Kathy facilitated a discussion about the ***possible*** use opportunities for Como Golf Course. A list of ideas is attached as a reference. In addition, the committee asked that the City help frame the discussion moving forward. They are interested in knowing whether we are talking about a reduction in the number of golf courses the City manages, or if we are specifically talking about taking Como Golf Course out of the system. If golf is in as difficult a situation financially as the City presents, they are not convinced taking only Como Golf Course out of service will solve the problem.
