


# RESULTS - online & paper survey

Q1 How often do you visit the park?




Q3 What's your favorite activity at the park?




Q8 What type of play equipment would you like to see in a new play area?

Answered: 27 Skipped: 3




Q9 What additional elements would you like to see incorporated into the new play area?

Answered: 28 Skipped: 2




Q10 What type of play surfacing would you like to see in the new play area?
