PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT GUIDE:

Athletic Field Lighting: There is currently sufficient lighting around the existing fields; however, additional lighting would improve the overall experience of the athletes and visitors.

Pedestrian Lighting Along the walkway connection between Congress and Clinton: Standard park lights to provide a lighted path when the fields are not in use.

Football Hash Marks between the Numbers: These lines are roughly 2' long by 4" wide.

Complete Soccer Field Markings: Include additional Age Group soccer field markings to run the width of the large field.

Complete Lacrosse Field Markings: Permanent lines installed into the turf to denote both boys and girls lacrosse field sizes. A common alternative to this option is to paint the lines on the turf. This method may require repainting several times per year.

Softball Field Markings: Additional Markings to denote base and pitching locations for different age groups for softball. Entire infield will be a brown colored turf.

Baseball Field Markings: Additional Markings to denote base and pitching locations for different age groups for youth Baseball. Entire infield will be a brown colored turf.

6' rather than 8' fence height: Install a 6 foot high fence around the perimeter of the fields rather than an 8 foot high fence.

Drinking Fountain: Install a drinking fountain between the Twins Little League Field and the New Artificial Turf Fields.

Mid-block Cross-Walk on Clinton to connect to Parque Castillo: Include a mid-block crossing across Clinton Avenue to promote safer access between Parque Castillo and the Gilbert De La O fields.
