

HEAVY LOAD PERMIT RESTRICTIONS-15
(revised 12/1/2009)

Load restrictions for axels and total load shall be as stated on the City issued Annual Permit. Further restrictions to Annual Permits are as follows:

The following bridges shall not be crossed with trucks that are heavier than Legal Loads for the designated route. Routes are shown on the City Truck Map that can be viewed on-line at: <http://bridges.ci.stpaul.mn.us>.

9 ton routes	-legal maximum total load 73,280 pounds
10 ton routes	-legal maximum total load 80,000 pounds

1. Randolph Street (Old Shepard Road) Bridge No. 7272 south of Shepard Road over the Union Pacific Railroad **73,280 lbs.**
2. Payne Ave. Bridge No. 62544 over the Union Pacific Railroad **73,280 lbs.**
3. Hamline Ave. Bridge No. 62502 over Ayd Mill Rd and C.P. Railroad **20,000 lbs.**
4. Wheelock Pkwy. Bridge No. 90396 over ravine and Sylvan St. **16,000lbs.**
5. Edgumbe Road No. L8804 over ravine near Hamline Ave **10,000lbs.**

In addition, loads exceeding the following dimensions require a separate permit each time they move on a street in the City of Saint Paul:

1. Greater than 12'-0" wide
2. Greater than 14'-0" high
3. Greater than 75'-0" long
