



## **EXISTING SITE PROGRAM**

Hamline Park is divided into four quadrants with different activities or uses in each.

North - play

South - sport/fitness

East - sports and community information West - open space, picnic tables, and art, as well as the historic Recreation Center building

The playground will be renovated to comply with ADA regulations. Deficient, broken, or unsafe equipment will be replaced.
