







Q5 Select your preferred color for the metal posts and guardrails on the play equipment.





Q6 What play surface do you prefer?





Q13 What is your age?





Q14 The kids I bring to Hamline Park are the following ages:





Q15 What neighborhood do you live in?





Q16 How far do you live from Hamline Park?




