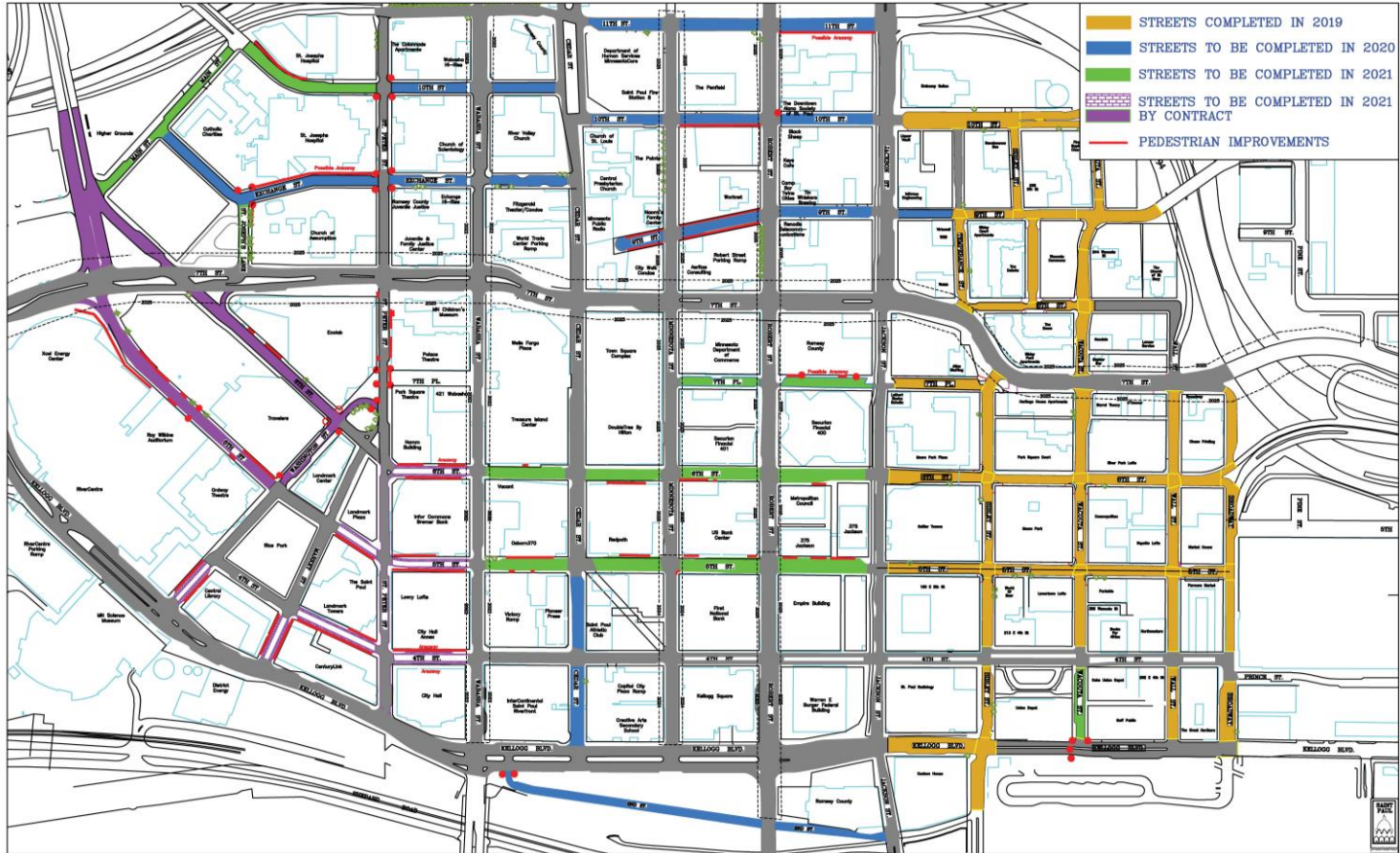


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# DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT



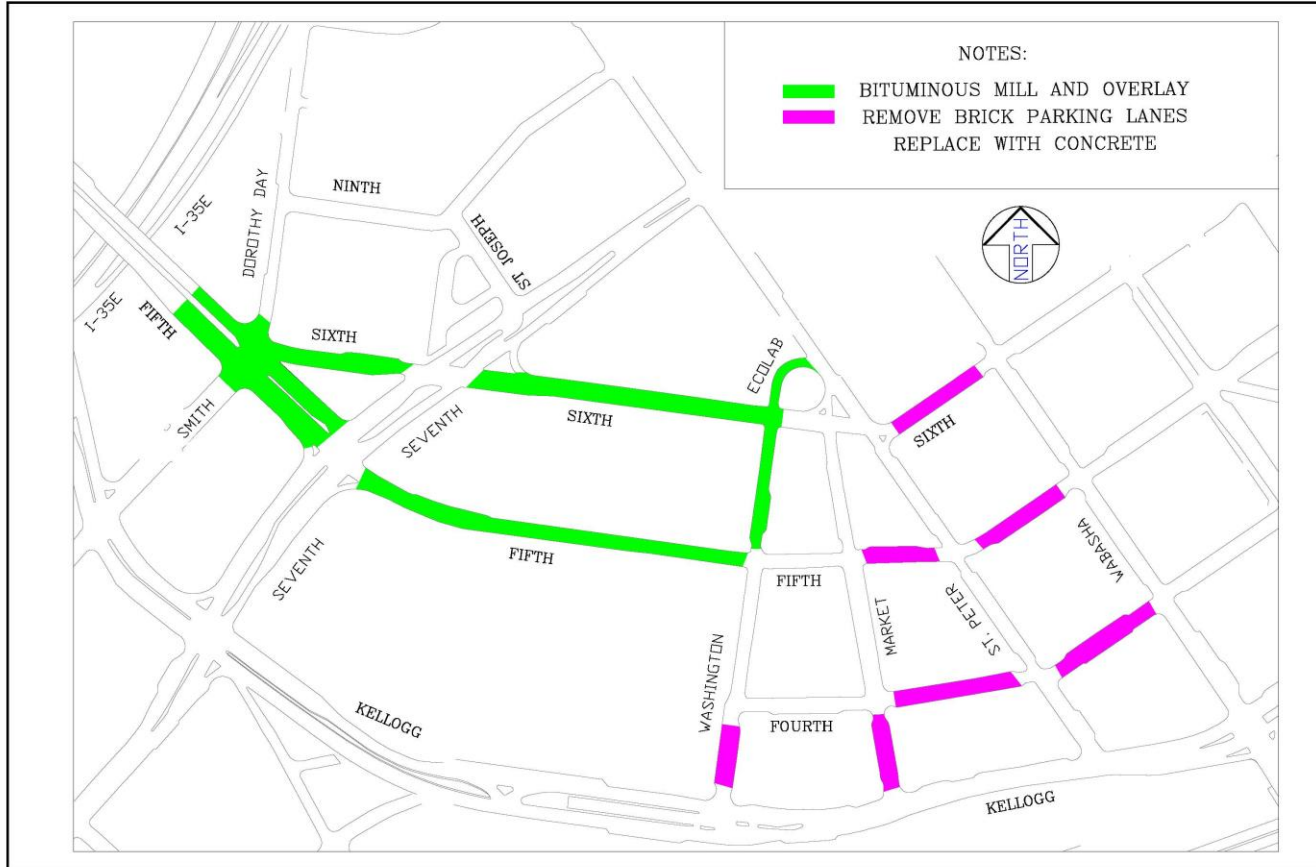


## Construction Timeline

- Purple Area: June to October 31, 2021
- Green Area: August to October 31, 2021



# Downtown Brick (purple area)





## Around Rice Park

- Per a request from the Rice Park Association, Saint Paul Public Works will not remove the clay brick pavers from streets abutting Rice Park (Washington Street, Market Street, 4<sup>th</sup> Street, 5<sup>th</sup> Street)
  - City does not have any current or planned funding or timeline for any major repairs or replacement of the clay brick pavers in these street segments
- Metro Transit has future Gold Line stops planned for the 5<sup>th</sup> Street and 6<sup>th</sup> Street sections that are not included in this project



## Downtown Streets (purple area)

### 2 types of streets:

- Traditional asphalt streets (green on downtown brick map)
  - 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Streets west of Washington and Ecolab Place
  - Treatment: Mill & overlay
- Concrete streets with brick parking lanes (pink on downtown brick map)
  - Washington Street and Market Street between Kellogg Boulevard and 4<sup>th</sup> Street
  - 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Streets between Market Street and Wabasha Street
  - 6<sup>th</sup> Street between St. Peter Street and Wabasha Street
  - Treatment: Remove brick parking lanes and replace with concrete



## Downtown Sidewalks

- Remove the brick pavers from sidewalks and replace with concrete
- Replace concrete sidewalk panels and curbs that are broken or in disrepair
- Construct ADA-compliant curb ramps at intersections to improve pedestrian safety

*Property owners/tenants connect with Public Works about areaways, vaults and access*



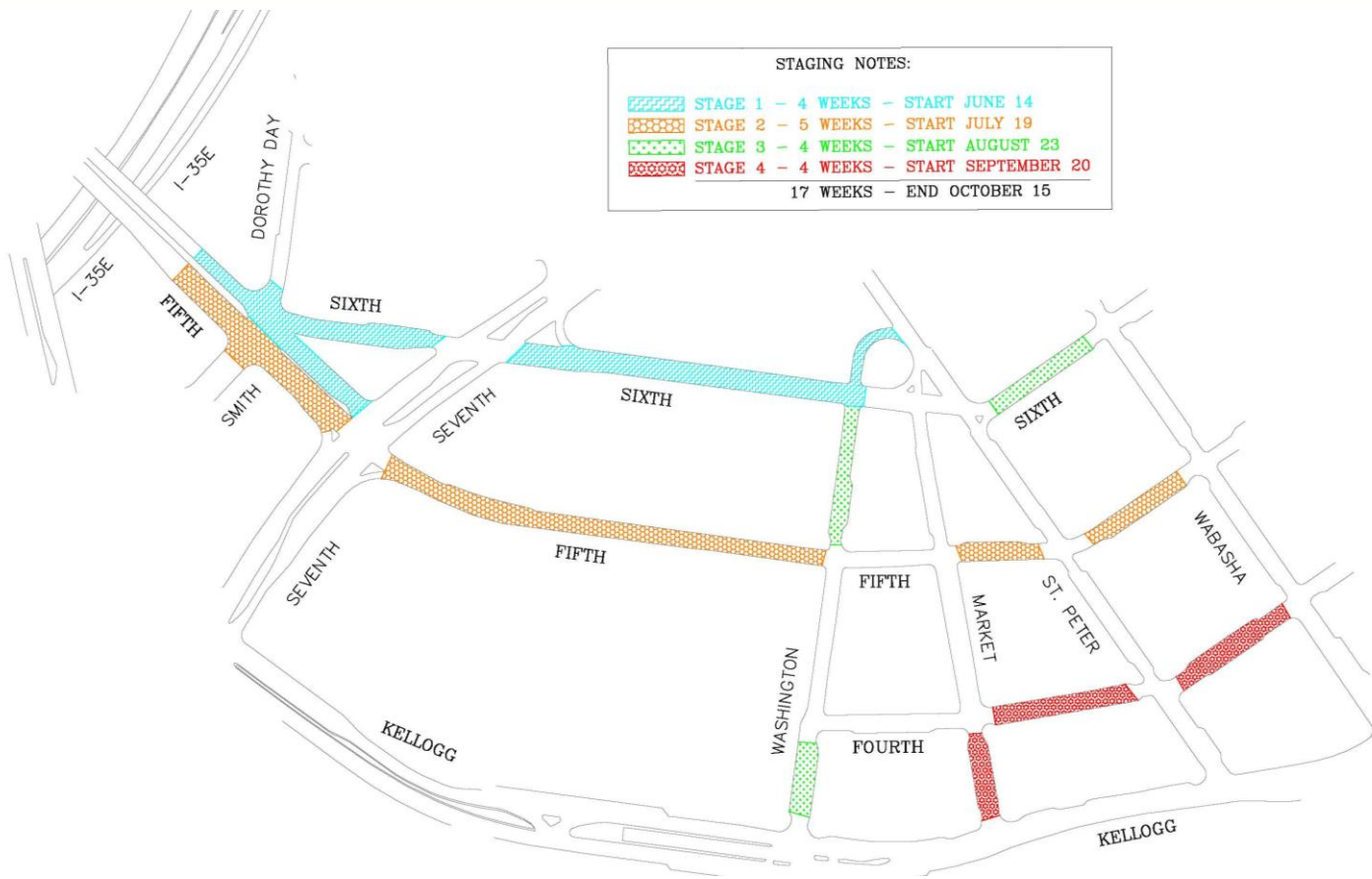
## Other Utility & Project Work

- Utilities in area before street and sidewalk work
  - District Energy – work on 5<sup>th</sup> Street in June
  - Saint Paul Regional Water Services – work at Travelers in May/June
  - Sewer Utility – catch basin replacement
- Potential lane and parking lane closures and restrictions
