

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
PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Hamline Play Area will be renovated in 2021.
- Current playground was installed in 1992 (29 years ago).
- Funding is from a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). a Federal source.
- Construction budget is \$256,000




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PROPOSED WORK

- The playground will be renovated to replace aged equipment and enhance compliance with ADA regulations.
- The area within the playground border will be modified for new equipment and new surfacing. The pathway from the parking lot and Hamline Recreation Center to the playground will be repaved to enhance playground accessibility.
- New playground equipment will be installed, incorporating public feedback from meetings held in fall 2020 and winter 2021.






PLAYGROUND COLOR Large Plastic Pieces Including Slides Sky blue - 28% Runners up: Light green (teal), Dark blue

We will address what we can within budget, and keep other items in mind for future improvements.







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


EXISTING SIGN


The survey gathered preferences for climbers to access play equipment.


