# JOHNSON PARKWAY REGIONAL TRAIL

04-20-2021 Project Update

## WHAT'S COMPLETED?



- Trail and roadway have been completed from Burns Avenue to Phalen Boulevard
- Retaining walls have been completed
- Most trees have been planted
- Sod has been installed from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to Phalen Boulevard
- All roadway signs have been installed
- Below ground items have been installed for traffic signals at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and 7<sup>th</sup> Street
- Most trail lights are operational

## WHAT'S LEFT TO DO?



- This week:
  - Traffic signal work at 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Johnson Parkway
  - Placement of temporary stop signs – to remain until the new system is operational
  - Realignment of pedestrian crossing at Burns Avenue and Johnson Parkway
- Next week and future work:
  - Install sod from Burns Avenue to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street
  - Install railings above retaining walls
  - Install trail wayfinding signs
  - Plant remaining trees
  - Install sidewalk at English Street and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and at Wakefield Avenue and Johnson Parkway
  - Stripe final roadway and trail pavement
