# What is WaterWorks?

*WaterWorks* is a voluntary contribution program initiated by Saint Paul Regional Water Services (SPRWS). It is jointly administered by SPRWS and the Community Action Partnership of Ramsey & Washington Counties.

Under the *WaterWorks* program, assistance will be limited to a maximum of \$300 per recipient annually, subject to fund availability.

To be eligible for assistance, families must:

- Be in financial crisis
- Qualify under Minnesota state median income guidelines from the US Department of Health and Human Services (HHS)
- Have a past due balance of more than \$150.

Your generous contribution to *Water-Works* will assist low-income families with paying their water and sewer bills.
