Unoccupied and unsecured OR Unoccupied and secured by other than normal means OR Unoccupied for one (1) year with history of nuisance orders (not necessarily boarded)	*FIRE EXEMPT	The seller must:
	Unoccupied due to fire damage AND Vacated OR Condemned	**Obtain a Truth-in-Sale of Housing report to market the property.
		The buyer (and/or seller) must:
		1. Register or re-register ownership PLUS 2. Pay outstanding fees
		3. Comply with existing or outstanding orders for legal occupancy

Unoccupied and secured by other than normal means (boarded) AND		The seller (or prospective buyer) must:

Condemned with conditions constituting material endangerment OR		2. Certificate of Code Compliance
Has multiple violations with conditions constituting material endangerment		OR 3. Fire Certificate of Occupancy

- * FIRE EXEMPT Category 1s are upgraded to Category 2 status if offered for sale before being restored to code compliance.
- ** A Truth-in-Sale of Housing (TISH) report is required to market a category 1 vacant building.
- *** A TISH report is required for marketing purposes if the property is offered for sale prior to obtaining the code compliance.
