What is the project schedule? A portion will begin in Fall 2021.

Has there been coordination with River Balcony project? Yes.

*Commissioner Bezat moved that the HPC concurs with the finding of No Adverse Effect as per the presented testimony, submitted documentation and information provided in the staff report and recommends the erection of a historic marker that highlights the history of the APE, buildings that have been lost and the involvement of Architect Clarence Wigington.
