
SUMMIT AVENUE MASTER PLAN

The Summit Avenue Master Plan will review the corridor from the Mississippi River to Downtown Saint Paul and develop a vision that can be used as a guide for future improvements.

The Master Plan will focus on a series of preferred cross sections, with emphasis for the Lexington to Victoria segment planned for reconstruction in 2023.


