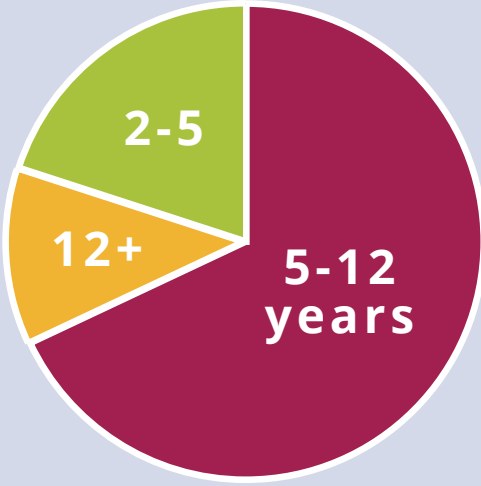


Dayton's Bluff Recreation Center Play Area Feedback Summary

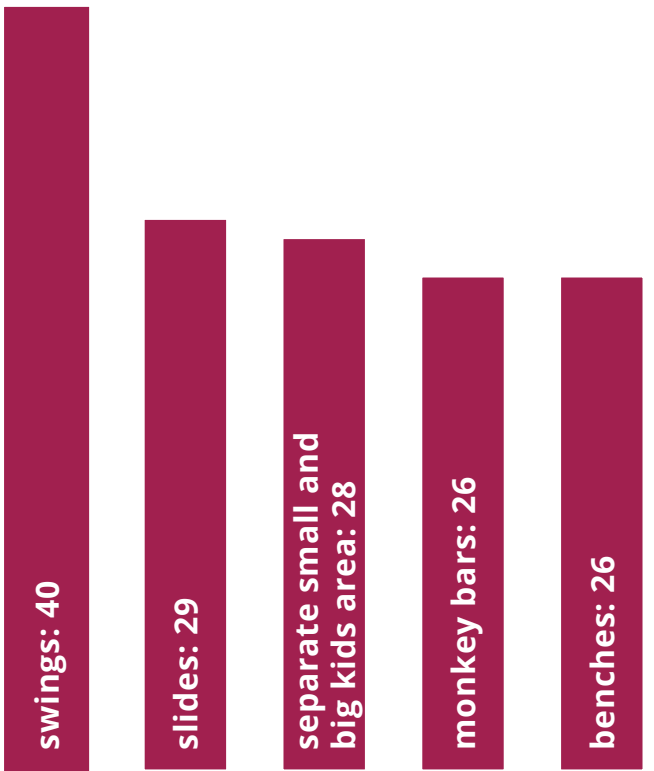
What are the ages of your children?



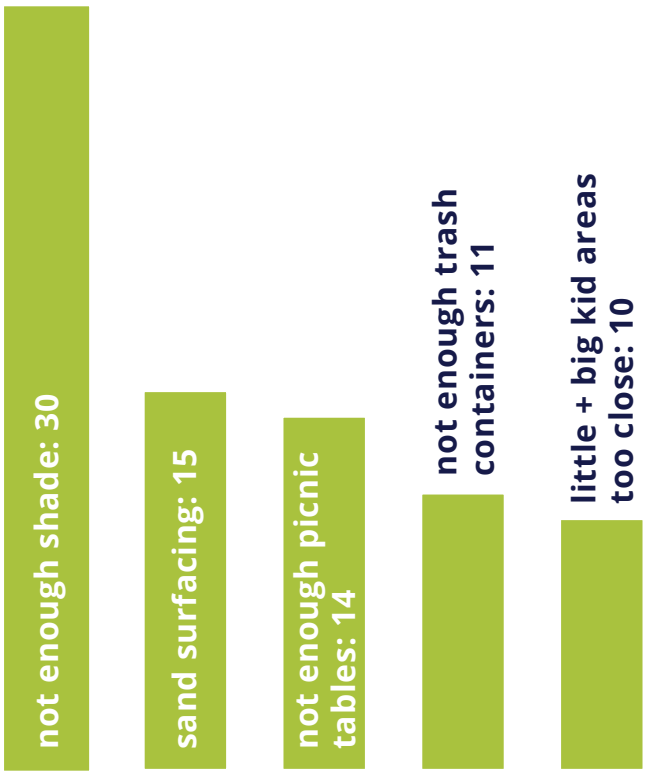
How often do you (your children) use the play area?

What are the best things about the play area? (top five)

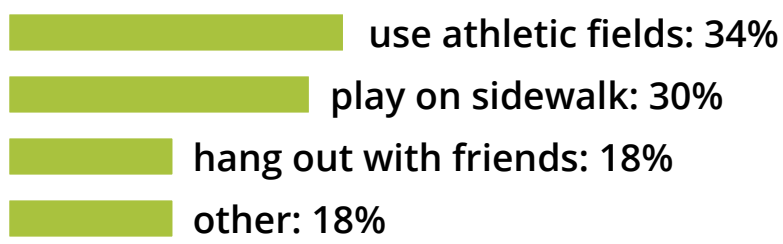


What are your least favorite things about the play area? (top five)
