Sanitary Tunnel Shaft Repairs - Ford Parkway and Woodlawn Avenue

Dear Saint Paul Resident:

Starting March 28, 2022, a Sewer Utility contractor (ECI) will begin repairing a sanitary tunnel shaft located at the intersection of Ford Parkway and Woodlawn Avenue. The tunnel shaft repair work is anticipated to be completed within four weeks. *Please see the attached map for the work site location.*

How the project impacts you:

- Ford Parkway westbound traffic will be reduced to one traffic lane between Mount Curve Boulevard and Woodlawn Avenue.
- Woodlawn Avenue will be closed to thru traffic between Highland Parkway and Ford Parkway. Access to driveways, parking lots, businesses, and residences will be maintained.
- Vehicles turning from Woodlawn Avenue on to Ford Parkway will only be able to turn right. No left turns will be allowed.
- Ford Parkway eastbound traffic will not be able to turn left on to Woodlawn Avenue.
- Bus Stop on Ford Parkway at Woodlawn Avenue will remain open.
- No parking signs may be posted adjacent to the work site. Please follow all posted signs.
- Sidewalks along the north side of Ford Parkway (at Woodlawn Avenue) will be temporarily closed. Please follow posted signs.
- Snow removal within the work site will be performed by ECI.

What is the cost?

There is no assessment cost to you. This project is funded by the Sewer Utility.
