# DESIGN UPDATE

## RESTROOM BUILDING SPACE REQUIREMENTS



- +/- 14' X 28' = +/-400 GSF
- Gender Neutral Restroom Stalls
  - » 80-90 NSF
  - » One (1) ADA Accessible Toilet
  - » One (1) ADA Accessible Sink
- Janitor / Storage / Mechanical
  - » 60 NSF
  - » Janitor Mop Sink
  - » Water Heater
  - » Mechanical Unit
- Covered Entrance
  - » 40 NSF

#### Coverage Area

» 2 Picnic Tables

#### Solid / Covered Roof

» Provide rain protection

### Light Fixtures

» Review options for integral or site lighting around facility




