

WORK STARTING NEAR YOU SOON

We're replacing a natural gas line along Wabasha Street, between 4th and Exchange streets, and along 4th Street West, between St. Peter and Cedar streets.



We're working in your community to continue to provide safe, reliable service and to enhance system resiliency during extreme weather. Our work needs to take place prior to the City of Saint Paul's Wabasha Street Reconstruction Project starting this summer. See the City's website for more information about their work:

While we work, you can expect:

- Temporary, partial road, street parking and sidewalk closures
- Traffic control measures including flaggers and detours
- Temporary one-lane access restrictions (driveways to remain open)
- Construction noise



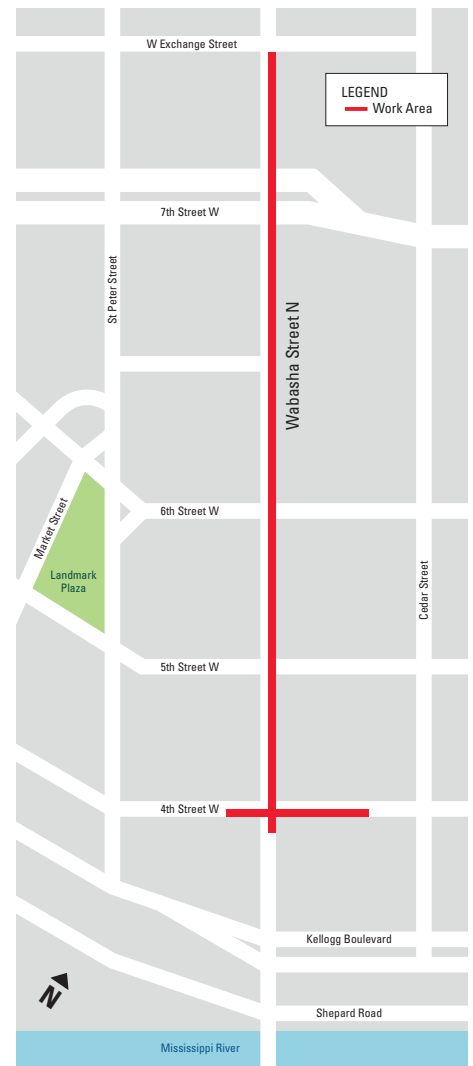
PSC Q3 Contracting is our construction contractor. Additional contractors will also work on the project.
