
### Where do you live in relation to Harriet Island Regional Park




#### How do you get to the park






### How often do you visit Harriet Island Regional Park



# What is your primary activity at the park?





#### **Site Considerations:**

Several temporary conditions will affect the site:

- Seasonal flooding in spring
- Flooding from extreme rain events
- Events in Harriet Island lawn space/performance area
- Staging for events adjacent to play area










**Conceptual Site Diagram**


