MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL AND THE SAINT PAUL SUPERVISORS ORGANIZATION

The City of Saint Paul (hereinafter "City") and the Saint Paul Supervisors Organization (hereinafter "Union") enter into this Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter "MOA") for the purpose of establishing a procedure to document and pay for attorney licenses for employees in classifications represented by the Union that require such a license.

The City and Union agree that the following terms and conditions apply solely and exclusively to the job classifications of Deputy City Attorney and Supervising Attorney:

- 1. Employees will provide the appropriate license renewal form to the CAO in a timely manner such that payment may be made prior to any deadlines for renewal.
- 2. The City shall pay the full cost of the license fee for retention of the employees' attorney license.
- 3. This MOA shall expire on December 31, 2022 and renew thereafter on an annual basis unless one party provides written notice to end the MOA.
- 4. This MOA sets no precedent.
