#### **EXISTING CONDITIONS**

- The corridor serves 8,000 vehicles per day
- Pavement condition through the project corridor is poor
- There are 6 bus stops for Route 63
- Generally, the right-ofway is 80 feet wide
- Dozens of businesses are located along the corridor
- Grand Ave runs through Macalester College

### **PROJECT DETAILS & BACKGROUND**

The City of Saint Paul plans to reconstruct Grand Avenue between Fairview Ave. and Snelling Ave. in 2023.

The project includes demolition and replacement of the pavement, sidewalks, and underground utilities along the corridor.

In 2022, residents, business owners and users of the corridor will be able to weigh in on the future of Grand Avenue.






# Cross Section 1: Grand Avenue through Macalester College campus
