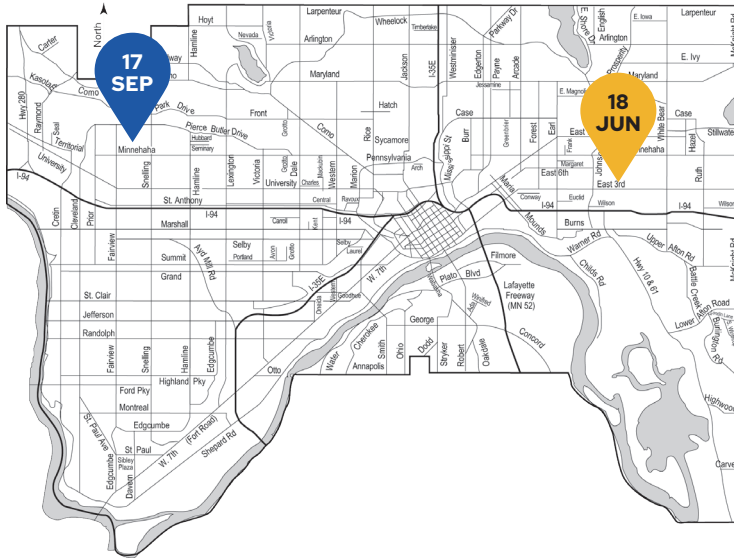

Bulky Items Accepted with Citywide Garbage Program

Residents in 1-4 unit properties with the City garbage service can have 2-3 bulky items collected at no additional charge each year. Items such as mattresses, electronics, appliances, and furniture are bulky items. You must call your garbage hauler to schedule pick-up in advance. For details, visit stpaul.gov/bulky.
