What To Expect In the Near Future

Extensive site preparation work will begin in late-March and progress throughout the summer. The first major step in the project will be **removing trees** to make space for new facilities and construction activities. Tree removal work will be followed by **demolition work** and **excavation**.

Unfortunately, these early steps are likely to be some of the most disruptive portions of the project for neighbors.
