



Capital City Bikeway Kellogg Boulevard Project

What is the Capital City Bikeway Kellogg Boulevard Project?

In 2023, the next segment of the Capital City Bikeway (CCB) will be constructed along the north side of Kellogg Boulevard from St. Peter Street to Jackson Street. The integration of this new 2-way separated bikeway will require reconstruction of the existing Kellogg Boulevard sidewalk, roadway and center medians. The project will also include improvements to drainage, underground utilities, traffic signals, lighting and replacement of the median trees.



What is the CCB?

The Capital City Bikeway (CCB) is a planned network of bicycle facilities throughout downtown Saint Paul. The bikeway network will connect to existing trails, effectively placing a majority of downtown within a few blocks of a bike and pedestrian trail. The first segment of the Capital City Bikeway was completed along Jackson Street from University Avenue to Kellogg Boulevard in 2017. The interim northern segment along 9th and 10th Streets was completed in 2020. A portion of the western segment will be completed along Wabasha Street in 2022.
