Our work will now continue north block by block rather than the original plan of skipping the block from 5<sup>TH</sup> St to 6<sup>TH</sup> St. We will begin work on this next block on August 15<sup>TH</sup>. A full closure of Wabasha St from 5<sup>TH</sup> St to 6<sup>TH</sup> St will begin August 22<sup>ND</sup>.

## WHAT'S HAPPENING?

- Wabasha Street will be reconstructed to replace the roadway pavement, sidewalks, curbs, and underground utilities including water and sewer.
- The Capital City Bikeway will be installed on the west side of Wabasha Street in conjunction with this project.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

- Wabasha St from 5<sup>TH</sup> St E to 4<sup>TH</sup> St E** – Left lane is closed and the right lane is open. Left sidewalk is closed.
- 4<sup>th</sup> St Intersection** – Intersection closure is scheduled to switch on 8/17.
- Wabasha St from 4<sup>TH</sup> St E to Kellogg Blvd** – Road and left sidewalk are fully closed. Right sidewalk is open.
- Kellogg Blvd Intersection** – Partial closure.
- 5<sup>TH</sup> St Intersection** – Partial Closure
