SPRWS is a public drinking water utility for the city of Saint Paul and surrounding suburbs. We serve approximately 450,000 customers. In order to meet this demand for reliable, high-quality drinking water, we treat and pump an average of 40 million gallons of water per day.

SPRWS consists of about 250 dedicated water professionals within four divisions:

BUSINESS DIVISION ASSISTANT MANAGER

Serves as SPRWS's Finance Manager and performs expert-level professional and managerial work in planning, directing, implementing, and evaluating the financial operations of SPRWS. Develops strategic financial plans and conducts rate evaluations to ensure strong financial health of the utility. Lead the development of the annual budget including funding for the estimated \$250 million plant project and provide oversight of grant funded projects including American Rescue Plan and Public Facilities Authority funding for the Lead Free SPRWS Program. Assist in the oversight of other Business Division teams including Customer Service, Meter Operations, and Information Systems.



PRODUCTION DIVISION ASSISTANT MANAGER

Performs expert-level professional and managerial work in planning, directing, implementing, and evaluating production operations of SPRWS. Direct project management of the \$250 million McCarrons Water Treatment Plant Project. Critical role in the development and implementation of the Enterprise Asset Management System throughout the division. Helps ensure compliance with federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and standards applicable to water supply and treatment. Assist in the oversight of Production Division teams including Supply, Water Quality, Maintenance, and Operations.
