

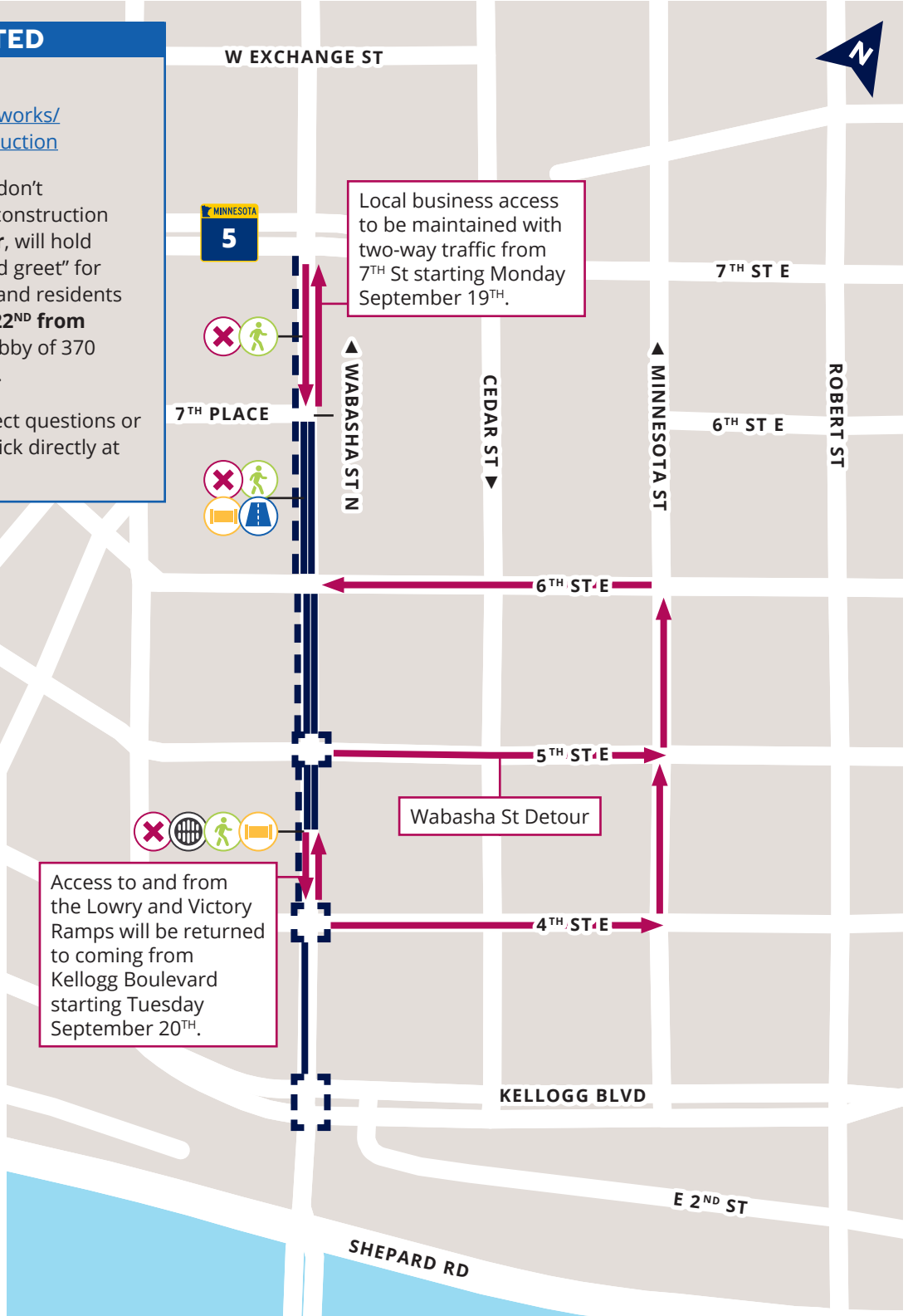

7th St to 6th St							Left sidewalk closed. Full vehicle closure from 7 <sup>TH</sup> Place to 6 <sup>TH</sup> St E.
6th St Intersection							
6th St to 5th St							Full vehicle closure. Left sidewalk closed.
5th St Intersection							Partial intersection closure.
5th St to 4th St							Full vehicle closure on north end of block. Two-way traffic on south end of block. Access to ramps coming from Kellogg Blvd returns starting 9/20.
4th St Intersection							Partial intersection closure.
4th St to Kellogg Blvd							Left lane closed to traffic.

## WHAT'S HAPPENING?

- Wabasha Street will be reconstructed to replace the roadway pavement, sidewalks, curbs, and underground utilities including water and sewer.
- The Capital City Bikeway will be installed on the west side of Wabasha Street in conjunction with this project.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

- Victory Ramp and Lowry Ramp – Access will come from Kellogg Blvd or 4th Street starting Tuesday 9/20.
- Wabasha Street from 5th St to 7th Pl will be closed starting Monday 9/19.
- Access to Treasure Island Center ramp will come from 6th St entrance only. Wabasha St entrance will be closed starting 9/19.
- 7th Pl to 7th St will temporarily be converted to a two-way facility to maintain local business access starting 9/19.
