Sewer Repair Work on Wabasha Street December 2022

Dear Saint Paul Resident:

Sanitary sewer repair work will be happening on Wabasha Street between Congress Street and Winifred Street beginning the week of December 12, 2022. The City of Saint Paul is working with a contractor (ECI) to construct a new sewer access structure over an existing sanitary sewer. *See attached map for project area.*

The sewer work is anticipated to be substantially completed before December 31. Final pavement restoration will be completed in spring 2023.

How this impacts you:

- Wabasha Street between Congress Street and Winifred Street will be closed to thru traffic.
- Driveway access will be maintained.
- No parking signs will be posted near the construction site. Please follow all posted signs.
- Sidewalks may be re-routed at times. Please follow all posted signs.

What is the cost?

There is no assessment cost to property owners for the sewer work.
